Hello Ladies and Legionnaires,

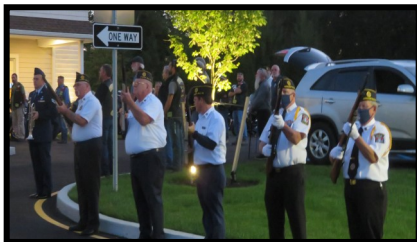
